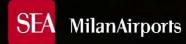

Thanks to its extensive infrastructure, it is the leading cargo airport in Italy and fifth in Europe in terms of freight traffic. Milan Prime at Linate and Malpensa are the facilities dedicated to Business & General Aviation managed by SEA Prime, the leading operator in Italy and third in the eurozone. Managed infrastructure includes two dedicated terminals and aprons, hangars, VIP lounges, meeting rooms and car parks. Milan Prime offers – directly or through its partners – a full range of services dedicated to aircraft, passengers and crew. The services on offer include concierge, hangars, maintenance, dedicated security filters, catering, supplies, limousines and tax refunds.

Ready for a new era

Safe, state-of-the-art, functional, technological, welcoming and above all sustainable: this is how Malpensa and Linate airports will be in the near future. A promise that is ahead of the game, ushering in the start of a new path of sustainability that revolves around three strategic elements we hold dear: **environment, people, community and local area**.



Sustainability. Our commitment: zero emissions by 2030

Milan airports are among the first airports to accelerate the target of zero CO2 emissions by 2030 compared to the planned date of 2050.

To achieve this, we are investing in innovative projects, most notably:

GREEN HYDROGEN POWER

The introduction of green hydrogen for fuelling aircraft and refuelling non-aviation vehicles. This also includes SEA's participation in the **OLGA** (hOListic Green Airport) project, approved and financed by the European Commission, through which our company has undertaken to build, with the collaboration of **Snam**, for the first time in an airport, Milan Malpensa, a hydrogen power plant both for airport vehicles and for connections to and from the airport.

SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY

Increasingly focusing on sustainable mobility such as trains, electric cars and metro to reach our airports

SAF FUEL

Use of **SAF** (Sustainable Aviation Fuel). SEA has signed an **agreement with ENI** to introduce in the short term refuelling of sustainable biofuel from vegetable and waste raw materials also on commercial flights

URBAN AIR MOBILITY

Building infrastructure for **Urban Air Mobility, such as the vertiports** we are planning near our airports

Self-service solution allowing passengers to check in their checked baggage completely independently

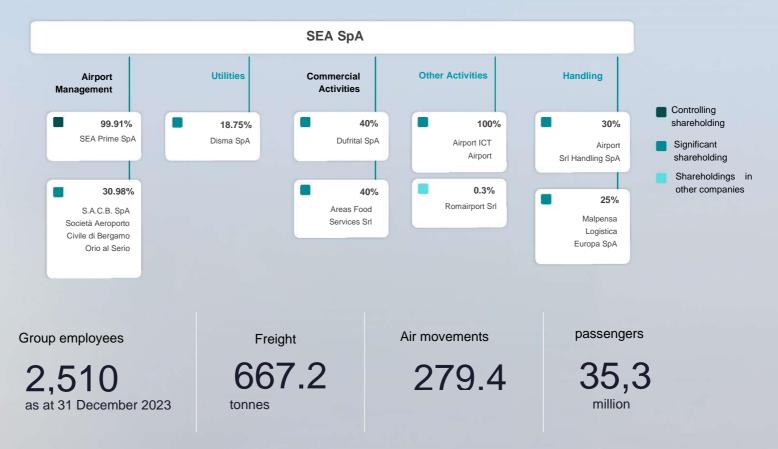
E-GATES
